

Sixth Form Uniform

The Sixth Form uniform at St. Hilda's was originally chosen by students at the school and has recently been modified based on student feedback. The Sixth Form uniform promotes equality between students.

Sixth Formers are expected to set a good example to the rest of the school in their appearance which should be smart at all times.

The SIXTH FORM UNIFORM consists of:

- A grey blazer with embroidered school badge: purchased from Trutex
- A **plain** white shirt that is suitable for wearing with a tie
- Black straight leg tailored trousers. These should be purchased from Trutex or John Lewis.
- A plain black sweater, cardigan or sleeveless pullover without trimming or logo. Hooded tops are NOT permitted
- Sixth Form tie: purchased from Trutex
- Plain black headscarf (if worn)
- Black shoes without trimming or logo
- Belts – black, plain and simple in design. No chains, studs etc

In addition, for girls:

- A choice of either the standard St Hilda's black inverted pleat skirt purchased from Trutex or John Lewis
- **Or** a black pencil skirt purchased from Trutex or the John Lewis Girls' School Sixth Form Skirt in black (see website)
- Plain black or flesh coloured tights
- Coats may not be worn in school

For both boys and girls:

- Facial piercings, with the exception of those in the ears are not allowed under **any** circumstances.
- If a student has a tattoo, it **must** remain covered at **all** times

Parents and students are expected to support this uniform policy as part of the student/school agreement.

Students who do not comply with the uniform code may be sent home to change. The final discretion about the suitability of any item is at the discretion of the Headteacher.
