

Catch Up Premium

The Catch Up Premium is additional funding to support Year 7 students who did not achieve the expected standard in literacy and numeracy at the end of Key Stage 2. Schools can spend the Premium in the way that will best support their students to make accelerated progress compared to their peers to enable them to fully access all aspects of the curriculum.

Catch Up Allocation for 2017 2018: £6,588

This funding will be used to provide:

- 1:1 support in literacy
- 1:1 support in numeracy
- Focused reading in library lessons to improve literacy skills

The Catch Up Allocation for 2016 2017: £6,457

This funding was used to provide:

- 1:1 literacy support
- Small group support in numeracy

Impact of Catch Up Premium 2016- 17

- Increased literacy skills leading to a positive impact on students' progress in other subjects.
