APPEARANCE AND UNIFORM 2019

St. Hilda's expects high standards of its students and uniform and appearance are no exception. This has been written so that all students may be confident in their smart appearance and represent the school with pride. School uniform promotes equality between students and ensures that students are appropriately dressed for all activities including PE.

Parents are expected to support the school's uniform requirements as part of the agreement between parents and school. When school and parents work in partnership, we create a pleasant environment for the children. We ask parents to ensure their daughter/son wears her/his uniform correctly and that it is clean.

GIRLS' UNIFORM

COMPULSORY

PURPLE BLAZER with school crest

WHITE BLOUSE: Plain, white, long/short sleeved button to collar blouse with a pointed collar. (No pintucks).

BLACK SCHOOL SKIRT: The school skirt has a central inverted pleat and should be at least knee length

BLACK TROUSERS: Plain, black uniform trousers ie straight leg, full length, tailored trousers. Fashion styles eg stretch/canvas/cargo/leggings/close fitting/cropped styles are NOT allowed.

SCHOOL TIE: School tie must be in house colour and purchased from Trutex

SOCKS: Plain black or white socks, knee length or ankle

or

TIGHTS: Plain black or natural tights

SCHOOL SHOES: Plain black with a flat heel. 'Plain' means not suede and without decoration. Shoes with heels, ie which measure more than 3cm on the inner part of the heel, are not suitable footwear for Years 7–11 as a health and safety issue. **Boots (including Kicker boots) are not allowed. Training shoes are not acceptable (eg black Converse, Nike, Adidas, etc).**

COAT: Plain coat. Coats must be removed inside school and placed inside the student's locker

SCHOOL BAG: Capable of holding an A4 folder

SCIENCE COAT: White lab coat

TECHNOLOGY APRON: Cream cotton

FOOD TECHNOLOGY APRON: White cotton

OPTIONAL

SWEATER or CARDIGAN: Black V-neck with purple/silver band (exclusive to Trutex)

HEAD SCARF: Plain black with no tassels or embroidery

PURSE BELT: Black (optional)

SCHOOL SCARF: Purple and white striped regulation school scarf or plain black

BOYS' UNIFORM

COMPULSORY

PURPLE BLAZER with school crest

WHITE SHIRT: White, long or short sleeved, button to collar shirt

BLACK TROUSERS: Plain, black uniform trousers ie straight leg, tailored trousers. Fashion styles eg canvas/cargo/jean styles are NOT allowed.

SCHOOL TIE: School tie must be in house colour and purchased from Trutex

SOCKS: Plain black or dark grey

SCHOOL SHOES: Plain black. 'Plain' means not suede or patent and without decoration. **Boots (including Kicker boots) are not allowed. Training shoes are not acceptable (eg black Converse, Nike, Adidas etc).**

COAT: Plain coat. Coats must be removed inside school and placed inside the student's locker

SCHOOL BAG: Capable of holding an A4 folder

SCIENCE COAT: White lab coat

TECHNOLOGY APRON: Cream cotton

FOOD TECHNOLOGY APRON: White cotton

OPTIONAL

SWEATER or CARDIGAN: Black V-neck with purple/silver band (exclusive to Trutex)

SCHOOL SCARF: Purple and white striped regulation school scarf or plain black

APPEARANCE

JEWELLERY

No jewellery is allowed other than one pair of small gold or silver plain stud earrings in the lower lobe of the ear. No other piercings are allowed.

ACCESSORIES

HAIR ACCESSORIES: Ribbons, hairbands and bobbles should be plain, of simple design and coloured purple, black or white.

No other accessories may be worn by students. Items banned include, but are not limited to: badges other than school badges

COSMETICS

No nail varnish, make up, acrylic nails, false eye lashes, henna tattoos or coloured contact lenses are allowed. Students wearing make-up will be required to remove it.

HAIR STYLES

Hair colour and style should be natural looking. Hair may not be worn in extreme styles. Students are not permitted to be shaven bald.
