The school building



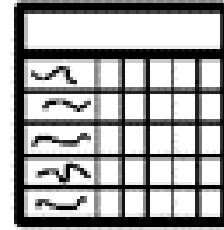
The adults who work at school and the children.



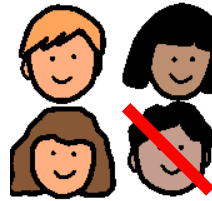

This is ok.

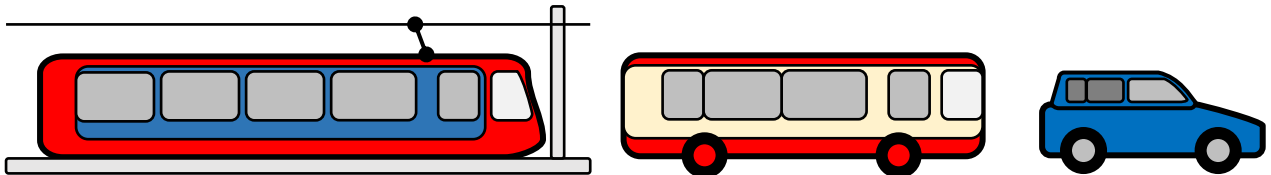


My day might be shorter and I may not go to school every day. This is ok.

This is ok.



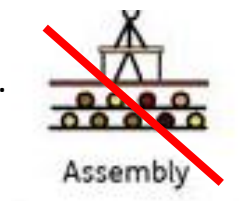
I might have different lunch and break times.

Sometimes change makes us feel worried or sad, **that's ok.**

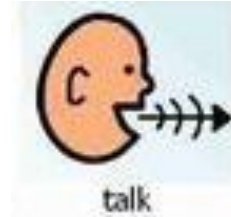
