What will I be doing?

As a Peer Researcher working as part of the Peer Action Collective you will be trained and employed to talk to people in your local community and people around the same age as you about specific issues, challenges and topics that matter to them. The work is fun and engaging and you'll be working with other young people who want a new challenge and to develop new and exciting skills.

Do I need to have qualifications or experience?

We provide you with on the job training, so you don't need qualifications or experience to become a Peer Researcher. We are just looking for people who are open minded and curious about the world around them. Having an understanding of the needs of young people experiencing violence or related issues will help.

Am I the right person to take part?

If you are interested in making a difference in your area and are keen to understand what matters to young people in your area, then this could well be the right opportunity for you! You just need to be curious, open to different ideas and opinions, able to work as part of a team, and willing to reflect on what you are hearing.
