Dear parent/carer,

Further to my letter yesterday advising of some of the difficult decisions I have made in order to support our Christmas break as cases rise, I am sending further details.

Tuesday morning would have been our Cathedral Carol Service. We are now doing this in-house. Not quite as grandiose as our usual venue, but as a Christian school it remains a priority. For Tuesday morning, students will be set work on Teams. This will be PSHE work as there are no scheduled lessons on that morning.

For the staggered return on Wednesday 5th and Thursday 6th of January, work will be created and posted on SMHW. The information will direct students to where that work can be found. Some staff may choose to set work on Teams, but this will be highlighted on SMHW for ease.

I have pasted the testing schedule below. The uptake of students wishing to have a test on-site is very high in our school. Please note, for parents or carers with more than one child here, please bring them to one appointment time. There is no need to travel back and to for different times. As further guidance, anyone who has had Covid after 8th October this year should not be tested in our January on-site testing. You are very welcome to do a home test, but any official test may bring about a positive result and a 10-day self-isolation period.

You may have seen that the guidance regarding self-isolation when in contact with positive cases has changed. I have pasted the guidance from the Department for Education below. All students have been given tests for the Christmas break and need to bring these home.

Daily testing of close contacts for COVID-19 – updated guidance for schools

From today, adults who are fully vaccinated and all children and young people aged between 5 to 18 years and 6 months identified as a close contact of someone with COVID-19, are strongly advised to take a lateral flow device (LFD) test every day for 7 days and continue to attend their setting as normal, unless they have a positive test result.
