Skills You'll Develop Studying A Level Music (Eduqas)

These skills are valuable far beyond music. They help you become a confident communicator, a creative thinker, and a disciplined, independent learner. Teamwork and organisation skills are essential in any career, while creativity and problem-solving are highly valued by employers. Studying Music shows you can combine artistic expression with academic focus — a powerful mix for future study or work.

- **Performance skills** – confidence, expression, and technical control on your instrument or voice.
- **Composition skills** – creativity, originality, and the ability to structure and develop musical ideas.
- **Listening & analysis** – learning to identify musical features, styles, and techniques by ear.
- **Understanding of musical context** – knowledge of genres, traditions, and cultural influences.

- **Performer** – musician, singer, or instrumentalist in bands, orchestras, or solo work.
- **Composer or Songwriter** – creating music for concerts, film, TV, or games.
- **Music Producer / Sound Engineer** – recording, mixing, and producing music in studios.
- **Music Teacher or Tutor** – teaching in schools, colleges, or privately.
- **Music Therapist** – using music to support health and wellbeing.
- **Arts or Events Manager** – organising concerts, festivals, or arts programmes.
