Basic Interview Techniques

Excelling in a tough interview is difficult, but the reality is that interviewees who prepare intelligently and work hard are the ones who perform well.

There is a particularly useful phrase, which you should always consider when you have an interview in the diary: 'Proper Preparation Prevents Poor Performance'. But as well as areas you can prepare for there are certain aspects of performing well in interviews that it's worth knowing about.

Make sure you consider all these basic interview principles well before your interview.

- 1. Find out about the industry and what the company or organisation does.** Spend time researching so you are absolutely clear. It will help you to make informed answers and ask pertinent questions.
- 2. Know your CV really well.** Expect to be asked questions about your CV: it looks unprofessional if you don't know it inside out.
- 3. Know your relevant experience as completely as possible.** How does it fit the role you are interviewing for? Where have you excelled in the past? Be ready to back up your achievements with facts and figures.
- 4. Highlight your relevant skills.** The interviewer will be looking to establish the skills you have and whether they are appropriate for the role. Make sure you know what they are and how to talk about them.
- 5. Have a few insightful questions ready.** Interviewers can base their hiring decision on the type of questions you ask, so spend time preparing and have several.
- 6. Check your appearance.** Always be smart, conservative and well groomed. Keep jewellery to a minimum and your mobile phone off. Play it safe – this is about maximising your chances of employment NOT about showing off your personal style.
- 7. Be punctual.** Try out the journey at least once before the interview and arrive early on the day. Give yourself an extra 30 minutes travelling time just in case.
- 8. Be polite and personable to everyone you encounter.** People hire people they like and whom their secretaries like. Always thank the interviewer for their time before and after the interview. They are giving up their time for you.

9. Be prepared to top and tail the interview. Aim to impress your interviewer with friendly, confident chat before the interview starts and, on the way, out. Even if you're not in the interview room the interview has started.

10. Demonstrate enthusiasm, interest, and confidence.

11. Ensure you listen and observe. The interviewer will be interested in what you have to say, but watch out for signs of confusion, agreement or strong interest and respond accordingly.

12. Be careful to avoid showing signs of nervousness such as foot tapping and drumming fingers, etc. RELAX.

13. Demonstrate desirable behaviours and attitudes. Integrity, motivation, enthusiasm, positivity, open-mindedness, flexibility, willingness to learn etc. are all attitudes in high demand by employers. Think about how you will convey them in the interview.

14. Show how you will contribute. The interviewer will want to understand how compatible you are with the existing team and how productive you will be.

15. Avoid talking too much. Keep answers to a maximum of one or two minutes. Let the interviewer jump back in with a question to keep the conversation active.

Make sure you perform well with the basics of interviewing and the hiring manager will give you more chance to elaborate on the more interesting points you have to make.


