Plans for Dezoning of Classrooms

After many months of disruption, I am delighted to be able to start thinking about bringing some normality back into school. Our students and staff have been displaced from their usual classrooms since September 2020. This has meant staff having to travel to classrooms that aren't their own and the problems this brings with it, students have been stuck in the same room for large parts of the school day and some lessons have not been able to be timetabled in specialist rooms.

With the rate reducing significantly, I am in a position to carefully start to address some of these issues and think about dezoning the teaching spaces. Students will still be in their year group bubbles but will now be able to travel to designated classrooms in the department areas.

Safety and well-being will continue to be paramount.

We will not be opening the gate on Ullet Road. Students should enter and exit the school site via the main gate on Croxteth Road. Year 12 will continue to use the main reception entrance.

We will continue to have separate entry and exits to the building for each year groups along with the use of separate stairwells. Breaks and lunches will continue to be staggered with each year group having their own dining space. Outside space will still be kept separate for each year group along with separate toilets.

Face masks are still compulsory in all communal areas, circulation space and stairwells. They must be worn in the school minibus, on any coach trips and on all public transport. It is courteous to wear face masks in lessons. Students should continue to leave their classrooms wearing a facemask. They no longer need to be worn outside.

We are introducing a new one way system for each floor which minimises congestion. We have discussed these changes with our Public Health advisor from School Improvement Liverpool and he has approved these changes. Our risk assessment has been updated to reflect the new proposed changes.

I am hoping to introduce these changes on Monday 7th June 2021. Students will have form time during lesson 1 where key information will be shared and new timetables will be given out.

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
