An important part of the programme focuses on employability skills. Students will work with our learner support team to develop a strong CV and cover letter, prepare for interviews and gain confidence in careers

PROGRESSION

If during your programme you successfully gain an apprenticeship, your course will convert to an apprenticeship. Often, employers will prefer candidates who have previously completed pre-apprenticeship training and have experience

FUNCTIONAL SKILLS

If you do not have Level 2 qualifications in Maths and English or GCSEs at this level, you may also be enrolled onto a Functional Skills module to complete these as part of your programme

WORK PLACEMENT

You will complete a two week placement with an employer closely aligned to your preferred trade.

This is your opportunity to gain real experience within a workshop environment, and impress the employer



New Futures Programme





The New Futures programme is led by Youth Fed in partnership with VOLA, a consortium of voluntary community enterprise. The programme offers support to people who are aged 15 - 24 and not in education, employment, or training (NEET).

Participants will be given comprehensive information, advice and guidance assessment and a personalised action plan.

You will have a Key Worker who will offer 1:1 mentoring and support. This support will continue after progression to employment, further education, an apprenticeship, or a traineeship.

We offer a bespoke programme to support young people who are at risk of becoming NEET. We have successfully signposted many young people into: Employment, education, and training.

We can offer support for the following:

- Mental Health Awareness
- Coping with Anxiety and handling emotions
- Confidence Building
- CV writing and completing application forms effectively
- Interview Skills
- Cyber Safety
- Mack Interviews
- Money management skills

Reviews will take place regularly to ensure personal targets are met and progression routes are achieved.

Scottish Power – Pre-Apprenticeship Programme



Scottish Power Engineering Pre-Apprenticeship Programme

This electrical engineering course will provide you with the skills and knowledge required to join Scottish Power as an Apprentice on their Apprenticeship Programme. The course is based in both the workshop and classroom ensuring you get a combination of practical and technical skills providing an introduction to the knowledge and skills needed for either an apprenticeship or higher-level studies in Electrical Engineering. You will receive a Safety Passport and gain Emergency First Aid qualifications as part of your programme.

As part of the course you will attend training sessions with Scottish Power at their training centre and at the end of the course may be offered a place on their apprentice programme.

You will receive a monthly allowance of £200 as a contribution towards travel and any course expenses.

If you are highly motivated and have a willingness to learn with a positive attitude, this course could be ideal for you.
