## PAC – Peer Researcher (12 posts)

The Peer Action Collective (PAC) is a project funded by the Youth Endowment Fund. It is a partnership that will recruit young people (16-25 yrs old) to undertake research with other young people to understand their experiences of violence with their communities and how best to tackle this through social action.

Funded by the Co-op, the Youth Endowment Fund and the #iwill Fund, the PAC is here to support you to take the lead. It's a ground-breaking network of Peer Researchers.
