Once the Immunisation Team has decided on dates and location of the Covid-19 vaccinations, I will pass that information on to you.

Can I thank you for your support on the re-introduction of masks? Your children reacted so well. For our new parents and carers, those who are exempt medically will have either a lapel pin badge and/or a card for their top pocket. The pin badge means that they will not be asked why they are not wearing a mask. You may have noticed your child returning with one of the badges from me yesterday!

As I always say, I am praying for the day when I do not have to write to you about Covid, but feel very blessed that I have such supportive parents, carers and students in our St Hilda's Family. You remain in our prayers too.
