## Why have mini options?

- Started them during the first lock down - Spring 2020
- Allows students to personalise their curriculum
- Students can choose the subjects they want to study
- Allows for more enjoyment
- Engagement with learning improves
- Behaviour improves
- Helps with option choices in Year 10
- Less movement of subjects in Year 10


## What about choices in Year 10?

- Students do not have to continue with a non-core subject in Year 10
- Students can choose a subject in Year 10 that they have not studied in Year 9
- There will be drop down days e.g. Art, Cross-Curricular so students will still gain key skills in subjects they may not have opted for


## What are the core subjects?

- All students must study the following:
- English
- Maths
- Science
- Humanities (Geography and History)
- At least one Modern Foreign Language
- RE
- PSHE (Personal, Social and Health Education)
- PE (will also work towards their Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award)


## Personal Subject Choices

- All students must choose at least one language to study
- If your daughter/son is in set 1,2 or 3 for languages, they must choose at least one language from French, German or Spanish. They can choose two languages if they wish to
- If your daughter/son is in set 4 for languages they must choose one language which is French
- All students must choose one Arts subject from the following:
- Art
- Music
- Drama
- All students must choose one Technology subject
- Design Technology
- Food Technology
- IT


## Personal Subject Choices

- If your daughter/son has chosen one language to study, they can choose any three from the following list. If your daughter/son has chosen two languages to study, they can choose one from the following

*They will also be asked to choose a reserve choice
