Sports Day this year is taking place at Wavertree Athletics track on Monday 14th July, students will be required to make their own way to the track for 9:20am. Gates to the track will be open from 9:00am. Students will be required to make their own way home from the track once events have finished at 14:15pm.

As we will be at Wavertree track for the whole day, **students will need to bring with them a packed lunch and snacks if required.** Students who receive free school meals funding will be entitled to a packed lunch and this must be requested beforehand, by completing the form on the link below. In order to prevent waste, we will not be making lunches that have not been requested.

We are hoping for warm weather. Please ensure that your child brings some water and sun cream, as students will be outside for the entire day and potentially exposed to the sun. If the event is to be cancelled, a Synergy message will be sent and students will be expected to attend school as normal on the Monday.

Students will have the opportunity to purchase snacks and refreshments at the track. The school hold no liability if students lose or misplace their money during the event. We are also hoping to have an Olympic Bronze Medallist, Kelly Massey, in attendance to present medals to our winners.

Students who are competing in events will come to the track in their PE kits. Students who aren't competing can either show their support by wearing their house colours, or wear their PE kits.
