Welcome to The St Hilda's Family

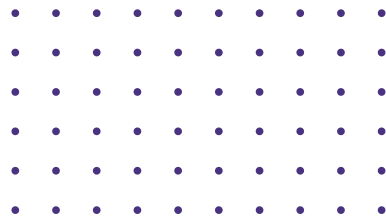
